

# Sewing

Grades: 7th – 12th

Prerequisites: General knowledge of sewing machine: how to wind bobbin, thread the machine and use sewing pedal.

Cost: \$35 Plus \$40 material fee per semester + cost of buying choice fabric for quilt

Credit: 1 unit of Elective

Overview: In this course, you will learn how to use your sewing machine to complete 4 projects including: making a decor pillow by ironing vinyl text to fabric, a tote bag, fox stuffed animal and t-shirt quilt. We will finish by learning to hand sew Christmas felt ornaments.

Curriculum: Instructor-generated handouts

Additional Requirements: A working sewing machine, sewing pins, thread, sharp scissors, seam ripper and t-shirts for quilt (12 min, 16 or 20 max).

Homework: 30-60 minutes for hand stitching or cutting fabric.
